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
Key principle for addressing REDD+

✓ Important primarily for addressing Climate Change, but maximizing multiple benefits through REDD+ is no less important than CC.









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Major areas of cooperation(1)

✓ Addressing underlying causes and drivers of deforestation & forest degradation, such as forest fires, inappropriate land-use patterns and unsustainable forest management.

Major areas of cooperation (2)

✓ Establishing robust and transparent MRV system.

(Asia, Latin America, Africa)






Major areas of cooperation (3)

✓ Enhancing research & development capacity





Case example (Vietnam)

Study on potential forest land for addressing climate change

Major components (1)

✓ Develop digitized nation-wide forest maps to detect historical trend of area changes.

Progress:

- Map on AR-CDM potential areas was produced.
- Forest maps for 1990, 2000 and 2010 were prepared.
- ➤ Preparation of additional forest maps for 1995 and 2005 is under consideration.
- ➤ National Forest Inventory data is under verification.

Major components (2)

✓ Establish reference emission level (on a trial basis)

Data analyzing is under way.



Major components (3)

✓ Survey on model land for potential REDD+ projects

Four (4) case studies are being conducted as model lands.


- i. Reduction of emission from deforestation and forest degradation by mitigating rubber plantation development in Binh Phuoc Province
- ii. Reduction of emission from deforestation and forest degradation through implementation of community forest management (CFM) and enhancement of forest management by forest company in Dak Nong Province
- iii. Development of forest plantation on shifting cultivation site in Nghe An province
- iv. Reduction of emission from deforestation and forest degradation through implementation of CFM in Kon Tum Province

Major components (4)

✓ Formulate REDD+ demonstration project Under consideration.
