History of International Negotiations on REDD+

COP11 (Montreal, 2005)	Original concept of REDD+ was proposed jointly by PNG and Costa Rica.
2008	WB- Forest Carbon Partnership Facility (FCPF) was launched by WB.
COP19	Set of technical guidance (Warsaw Framework) were
(Warsaw, 2013)	agreed.
COP21	Implementation and support of REDD+ is encouraged
(Paris, 2015)	in the Article 5 of the Paris Agreement.
GCF B.18	Terms of Reference of the pilot programme of REDD+
(Cairo, 2017)	Results-based Payment was approved.



Global Architecture of REDD+ Programmes


